The Nome Joint Utility System facility consists of one tank farm with four 847,000-gallon bulk storage tanks, four 20,000 gallon intermediate tanks, and one 23,000 gallon maintenance tank for a total tank farm capacity of 3,463,446 gallons. Diesel fuel is the only product stored in large volume. The facility is located near the mouth of the Snake River on the north shore of Norton Sound.

Effective July 10, 2021, the harbor launch ramp ('Barge Ramp') will be undergoing repairs and unavailable for use until the project is complete, sometime between **September 15th-30th**.
