Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)
PUBLIC MEETINGS and ANILCA 810 SUBSISTENCE HEARINGS**

The U.S. Department of the Interior (DOI), Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Alaska, prepared an environmental impact statement (EIS) to evaluate the effects of opening lands subject to the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) 17(d)(1) withdrawals within the lands described in Public Land Orders (PLOs) 7899 through 7903. The Draft EIS considers the revocation of ANCSA 17(d)(1) withdrawals in the Bay, Bering Sea-Western Interior, East Alaska, Kobuk-Seward Peninsula, and Ring of Fire Planning Areas. Revocations could open the lands to mineral entry or leasing, and potential subsequent development. Revocations could also lead to the conveyance of land out of Federal ownership, including through the Statehood Act, which would remove the Federal subsistence priority from these lands.

The BLM invites comment on alternatives, information, and analysis in the Draft EIS and is hosting public meetings to share information on the EIS and gather comments. Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA) 810 Subsistence Hearings will be held concurrently with the public meetings.

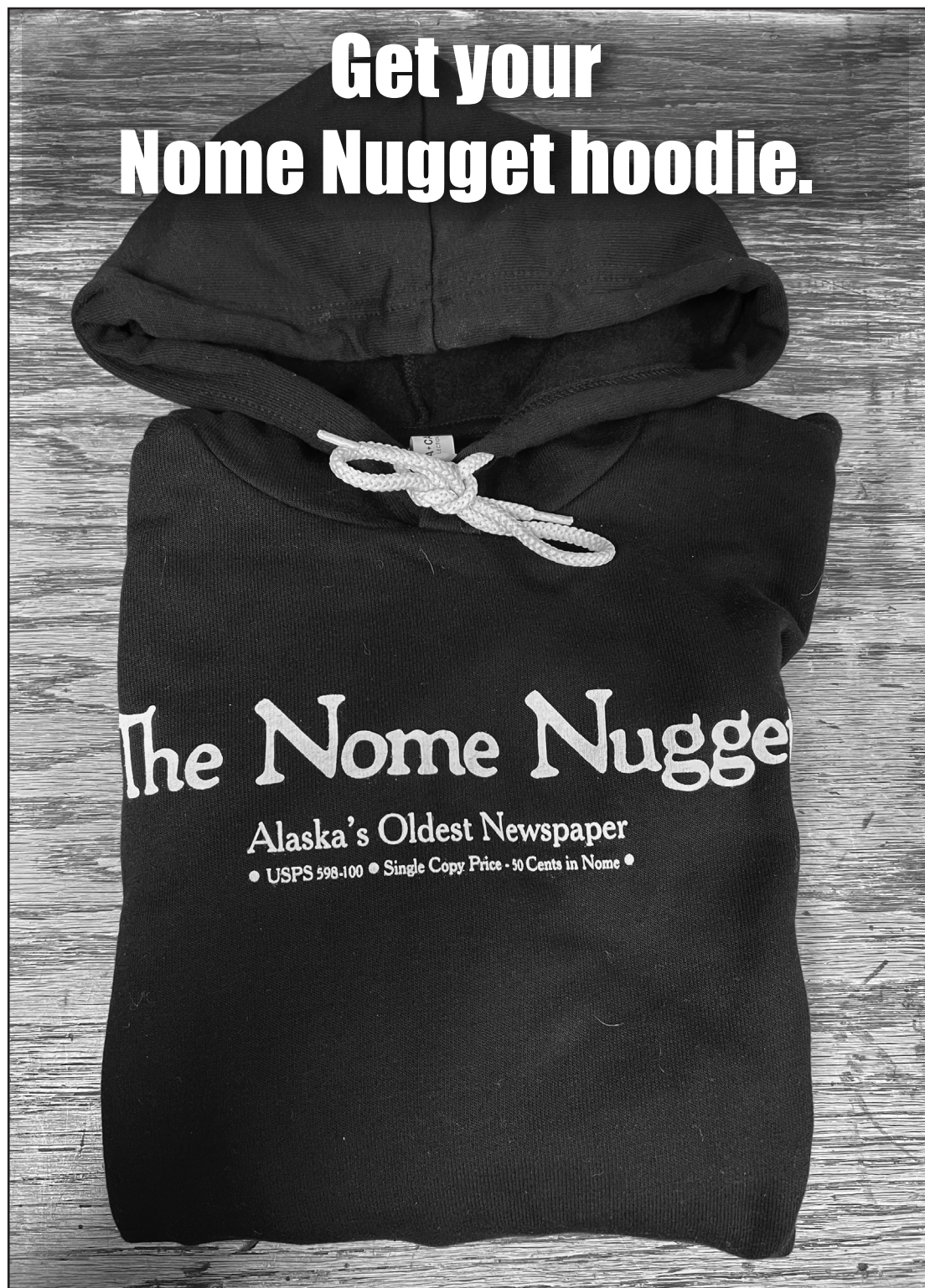
