Alaska Waste proposes to change the frequency of its cost of fuel surcharge (COFS) filings from quarterly to biannual. Alaska Waste proposes to file the COFS filings 60 days after the end of the second and fourth quarter.

This notice does not contain all requested revisions and the Commission may approve a rate or classification which varies from that proposed. Nome Police Department activities reported between April 27, 2020 – May 3, 2020.

During this period there were 427 calls for service received at the Nome Police Communications Center; 186 (43%) of these calls involved alcohol. The Nome Volunteer Ambulance Department responded to 5 ambulance calls. The Nome Volunteer Fire Department responded to no fire calls during this period.

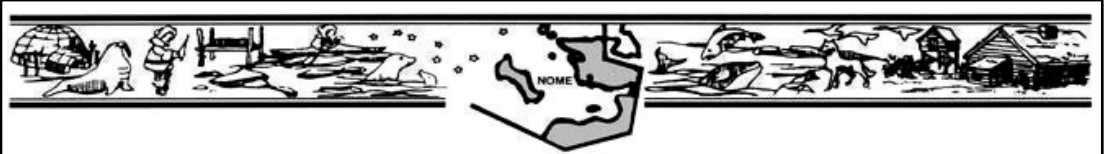
Traffic

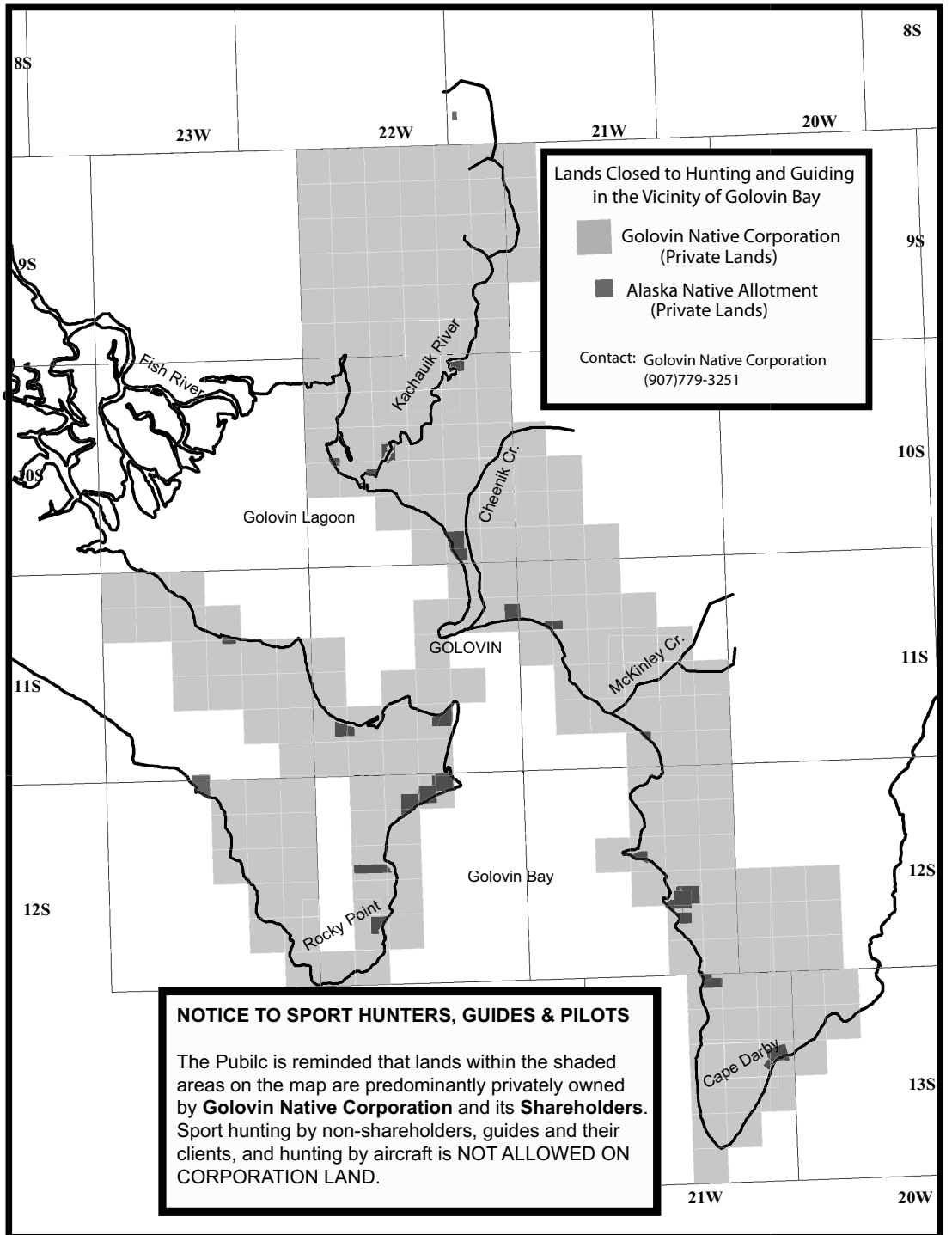
