The City of Nome will receive sealed bids to perform construction activities to repair the Cape Nome Jetty which was damaged during a 2022 storm designated FEMA PA-10-AK-4672. Repair of the Cape Nome Jetty will include survey, mobilization for all work, demobilization, repair of damaged sheet pile, dredging and disposal, supply and placement of imported fill, filter rock, B-rock and armor rock, and demolition and replacement of a mooring bollard.

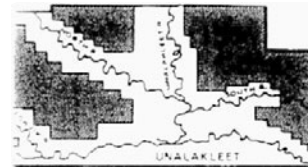

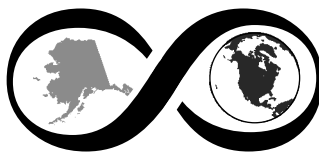

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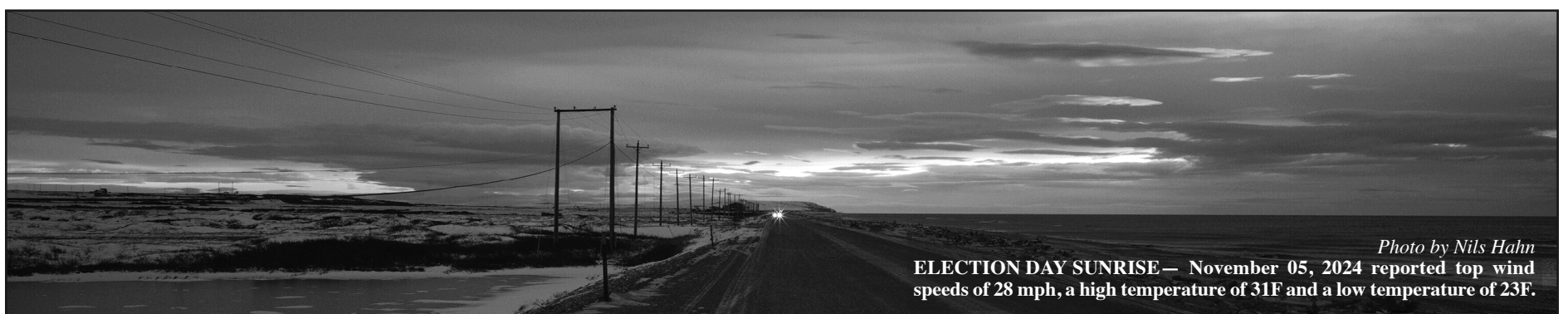
