The terms of directors, Phyllis Clough, of Old Harbor, Helena Jones of Ambler, and Peter Demoski of Nulato, end in April 2024. They are eligible for re-election. Nominees for the board of directors must be members of AVEC and have no past due accounts. All Board seats are at-large, representing the entire membership. Board members are elected by a vote of the entire membership and serve a three-year term.

AVEC members who are interested in serving on the AVEC board of directors are encouraged to send a completed nomination form to the nominating committee. The nominating committee, composed of six community delegates, will review eligibility requirements, and select members to be included on the ballot. As an alternative to selection by the nominating committee, members in good standing can also be nominated by ten or more other members.
